



Teton County Mosquito Abatement District Board of Trustees Minutes of July 27, 2011 Meeting

Call to order Dan Burr presided by telephone called the meeting to order at 6:40 PM at the Old Teton County Courthouse 89 N. Main, Driggs, ID.

Attendees Dan Burr by telephone, Jack Liebenthal, Summer Winger, and Alan Loe representing the contractor, Vector Disease Control Incorporated (VDCI). No public was present.

Review and approval of previous minutes Jack moved and Summer seconded the approval of the minutes of the June 29, 2011 meeting and the minutes were approved.

Report from VDCI

- Surveillance data for May and June were presented.
- High water and high mosquito activity this year.
- The extent of water makes larviciding impractical and adulticiding will be more necessary.
- In the last 2 weeks decaying vegetation has produced numerous Culex mosquitoes everywhere.
- No positive West Nile mosquitoes have been found.
- There will be an aerial spray soon. Coverage will be greater over 2000S to 6000 S than before and cut back in the North. A map of the last spray was displayed as the basis, with modifications, for coverage.

The Board expressed satisfaction with the report.

Financial update & budget preparation for next year

- Operating and cash flow figures (attached) were presented. The year should end with a positive balance and the District should be in the black throughout the next year.
- Budgeting for a vehicle for the District was discussed. It was the consensus that a vehicle is needed. It will be proposed that the District procure the vehicle the County pay for operations and maintenance.
